## DANGER:

- Flammable.
- Irritant effect on: eyes / Skin / Air Passages.

- May form explosive mixture with air, in empty uncleaned containers.
- Heating will cause pressure rise with risk of bursting and exploding.

### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- Goggles or Face Shield, Light protective clothing.
- Protective Gloves / Protective Footwear.
- Eyewash bottle with clean water.

### **EMERGENCY RESPONSE EQUIPMENT**

- Appropriate Spill Kit.
- Rubber or Plastic Shovel / Broom.
- Suitable absorbent.

## SECTION 5. DRIVER FIRST ACTIONS / DRIVER SPECIAL / ADDITIONAL ACTIONS

# DRIVER FIRST ACTIONS

- Stop the engine.
- No Naked lights / No smoking.
- Mark the roads with self-standing warning signs and warn other road users or passers-by.
- Keep public away from the danger area / Keep upwind.
- Notify police and fire brigade as soon as possible.

## DRIVER SPECIAL /ADITIONAL ACTIONS

- Any action / Spill containment only if without personal risk.
- Contain or absorb the liquid with suitable material.
- Avoid direct contact with the substance.
- Avoid making sparks.
- Prevent liquids entering the water courses, sewers, work areas.
- If substances have entered a water course or sewer inform the police.

#### SECTION 6. **DRIVER ACTION IN CASE OF FIRE**

Do not attempt to deal with any fire involving the load.

## SECTION 7. FIRST AID

- Start and continue medical treatment until medical assistance is provided.
- Burns: Cool affected skin as long as possible with cold water
- Eyes: Immediately was out with plenty of water.
- Remove contaminated clothing immediately and wash affected skin.
- Apply artificial respiration only if person is not breathing or under medical supervision.
- If any symptoms are visible apparently due to Inhalation / Swallowing / Contact with eyes.
  Transport to a medical facility for further treatment and observation.

## SECTION 8. SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

- Keep containers cool by spraying with water if exposed to fire.
- Extinguish with water spray or preferably with foam or dry chemical.
- Use low-sparking, explosion proof tools and electrical equipment.
- Do not use water jet.
- Sewers to be covered, basements and work areas evacuated.
