## WEDGEWOOD OPULENT TEXTURE COAT (contd.)

### **SURFACE PREPARATION:**

Ensure all surfaces are dry, less than 12% moisture content, and free from dirt, dust, chalking, oil, grease and any other contamination before painting.

#### **Unpainted Substrate:**

Cement plaster, concrete, ceiling boards, fibre cement, gypsum board.

- Prime with one coat Wedgewood Opulent 2 in 1 water based primer/topcoat.
- o Apply two or three coats Wedgewood Opulent Texture Coat, depending on colour.

### **Previously painted substrate**

- Remove all loose and flaking paint by scrapping, sanding or hydro blasting allow to dry.
  Clean with *ProLong ProSoap or ProLong ProSoap Liquid* to remove all contaminants. Rinse off *ProLong ProSoap/ProSoap Liquid* with water.
- o Apply two or three coats Wedgewood Opulent Texture Coat, depending on colour.
- If the surface is chalky and cannot be thoroughly cleaned, apply one coat of *Opulent Bonding Liquid*, allow to dry overnight, then apply two or three coats *Wedgewood Opulent Texture Coat*, depending on colour.
- o Fill defects with ProLong Crackfill or ProLong Profill, as part of the preparation.

Mould/Algae. Remove by scrubbing with a solution of 4:1 Water/Bleach or Water/Chlorine. Saturate affected areas and allow to stand for a minimum of 4 hours. Rinse off thoroughly with clean water and allow to dry before painting.

## **APPLICATION:**

Apply two (three coats for some low hiding colours) un-thinned to prepared surfaces so as to achieve complete obliteration.

Using a lambs wool roller apply using a combination of overlapping vertical, horizontal and diagonal strokes. Do not over apply (spread) the product.

Note: Brushing may give an uneven finish.

## **CAUTIONS:**

- Avoid painting during inclement weather or if temperature is below 10°C.
- For optimum performance a practical recommended spreading rate of 4 m² / I should not be exceeded.
- Do not over spread the product.
- It is very important to purchase sufficient paint to complete the project. Different batches may result in slight variations in colour that are beyond the control of the manufacturer.
- Do not apply to concrete or plaster substrates that contain more than 12% moisture

## **SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:**

- Keep out of reach of children.
- Ensure good ventilation during application and drying.
- In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water or a recognized skin cleaner. Avoid contact with eyes –
  In case of contact, rinse eyes immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice if symptoms
  persist. If ingested give plenty of water / milk. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention.
